Hayon's latest creation, AQHayon, lends legitimacy to the idea of bathroom couture. Minimal-meets-Baroque and over-the-top but still utterly practical, the curvy, voluptuous sinks, laser-cut mirrors and shapely tubs and cabinets come in 24-karat gold, platinum, glossy black or high-octane yellow. Notice the almost surrealistic details: Small mirrors and working lamps seem to grow fluidly out of the basin, once again bridging the gap between the worlds of art and design.
