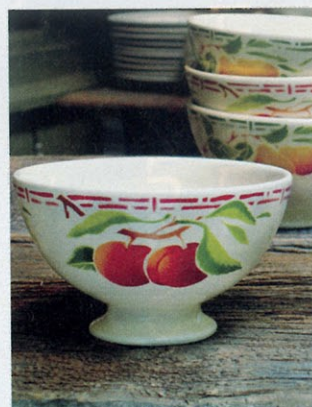
Moroccan Reflections
