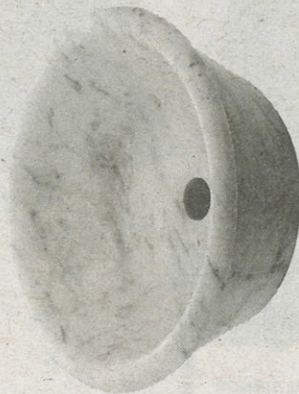
Start splashing around in one of these vessels and you'll feel like a bath-time MVP

The Perfect Chisel 1645 Round Exotic Stone Vessel, a green and brown marbled onyx number, looks as though it was plucked straight from your jewelry box.

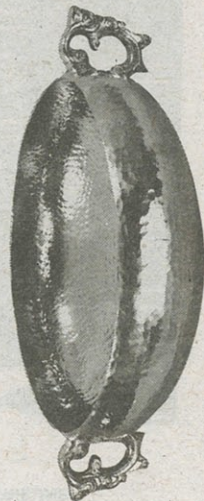
